Vision

To see the churches united in public worship of the Lord Jesus Christ and Christians working together to impact their city with praise, prayer, and proclamation.

Mission

To provide leadership, coordination, and training for an emerging national network of Christians who build a local relational network that mobilizes the Body of Christ.

Churches rise above differences to come together around what we all have in common—the Lord Jesus Christ. March for Jesus helps build strong relationships and unity among churches.

The Church Outside Its Walls

Worshipping Jesus in public makes the event a demonstration of our love for God, our love for one another and our love for the communities where we live. Taking the walls off the church makes us visible, accessible and reminds everyone of God's great love for all people.

MARCH CODE OF CONDUCT

- Joy is the primary expression at the March for Jesus. Even boisterous expressions of joy, such as cheer, are appropriate. Your countenance and manner should express the joy of knowing Jesus and being a part of his family.
- Protest signs and banners will not be allowed. Our policy excludes signs, banners and T-shirts that promote causes we may agree with as well as ones which we disagree. The only agenda today is to exalt Jesus.
- No group is allowed to identify itself. This includes churches, clubs, associations and causes. Everyone here is to identify with Jesus.
- Misconduct by spectators should be met with a kind smile to express peace and forgiveness.
- 5 No pamphlets or flyers are to be distributed at the March other than materials provided by the March for Jesus organizer.
- Please respond to your March Leader and Praise Leaders. These volunteers are trained to guide you through the March.
- Members of the police department are escorting us today. Let's leave the grounds looking better than when we arrived.
- Welcome everyone who joins us. Receive with grace those who may not represent your standards of faith and conduct.
